Four Seasons Resort Seychelles

### Suite 116

The recently opened Four Seasons Resort Seychelles sits on a jungle-covered hillside on the south-west coast of Mahé, an island first inhabited in the 17th century by pirates. Its ecologically aware architects have gone to great lengths to protect the pristine location, building each of the 67 hotel suites on stilts. The result is a luxurious take on the treehouse, set high among the branches of palm, mango, jackfruit and fragrant cinnamon trees. This is a view from the living room of a

two-bedroom suite, looking west across the sheltered Bay of Petite Anse and out to the Indian Ocean. Just out of shot is the villa's infinity-edged plunge pool and, at the foot of the hill, the fine, powdery white sand of the beach. The curve of the headland means these waters are sheltered, calm and ideal for swimming.
